SOUTHERN AFRICA-INDIAN OCEAN DIVISION

The Southern Africa-Indian Ocean Division is the newest of the world church's divisions. Some 2.2 million Seventh-day Adventists live here, a ratio of one Adventist for every 68 people.

The people of Angola struggle to rebuild following almost 40 years of war that damaged or destroyed hundreds of churches and schools. Lack of funds hamper the rebuilding projects, leaving thousands of children with no school to attend.

Zambia is one of the world's poorest countries. Almost 574,000 Adventists live there, a ratio of one Adventist for every 20 people. In 2003 the church opened Zambia Adventist University, and more than 800 students are enrolled. They lack classrooms, dormitories, and most other essential structures.
